



Penguin Boot Cuffs



Instructions:

Boot cuff (make 2)

Cast on 58 sts in yarn A.

Knit into the back of the sts to form a neat edge.

Using the chart place pattern as follows:

Odd row numbers are knit and even numbers are purl.

Row 1: *k2A, k3B, k2A, k3B, k6A, k3B, k2A, k3B, k5A* rep once more.

Continue working from the chart until row 18. Cut off yarn C. The rest of the knitting is done in yarn A.

Row 19: knit.

Row 20: purl.

Now continue in ribbing.

Ribbing

Row 1: *k2, p2* rep until the last two sts, k2.

Row 2: *p2, k2* rep until the last two sts, p2.

Rows 3–20: rep rows 1 and 2 nine more times.

Row 21: as row 1.

Row 22: cast off sts.

Making up

Use a tapestry needle to sew in loose ends by weaving them into stitches at the back of your work.

With RS facing, use a mattress stitch to join the side seams of the pattern component of the boot cuff.

Sew up the rib on the rear side of the boot cuff.

Materials:

★ Two balls each of DK (8-ply/light worsted) pure alpaca yarn in pale turquoise (A) and 1 ball each in gold (B), mid-blue (C) and cream (D); 50g (1¾oz)/100m/109yd

Needles:

★ 5mm (UK 6, US 8) knitting needles
